command of Adonai. **He buried him** in the valley in the land of Moab, near Beth-peor; and no one knows his burial place to this day.

Devarim/Deuteronomy 34:1, 5-6

He buried him — Specifically, The Holy Blessed One in glory buried Moses (Sotah 14a)

Rashi on Devarim/ Deuteronomy 34:6

While the Holy One is not directly involved with the burial of our loved ones as described above, the Divine Presence is manifest through the Chesed (lovingkindness) of the members of the Chevra Kadisha. Often translated in English as "Burial Society" the literal meaning is "Holy Community" reflective of the sacred task of preparing the deceased for their final physical journey, doing so with delicacy, sensitivity, and respect for the deceased.

The Torah shares very few details regarding the burial process. What we can glean from the deaths described here as well as what we learned from the burial of Abraham and Sarah is that a burial takes place quickly after

the person's death, the burial place must be properly marked, and that the responsibility for doing so falls to the family of the deceased.

The existence of the Chevra Kadisha allows those who have experienced a loss to focus on each other and other immediate necessities knowing that their loved one is well tended. This is especially true in a small community such as ours where the members of the Chevra Kadisha are performing a Taharah for someone with whom they may have prayed in the sanctuary, shared in a simcha, or worked together on behalf of the Jewish community.

The activity of the Chevra Kadisha is guided by the principle of K'vod Hamet, honoring the deceased by showing respect, which informs the group in their interactions with the deceased during the Taharah, the special ritual process.

Education Director's Message



Parking Lot Questions

We learn in the Talmud that "every community must appoint teachers, for the world exists only through the breath of schoolchildren." The community risks ostracism or destruction if it fails to provide teachers (!) We have found that appointing [begging] teachers is easier said than done. Prospective teachers frequently voice a concern about not being knowledgeable enough. One part of our solution is to provide fully scripted lesson plans supplemented by "The Parking Lot Questions for Rabbi."



Our students ooze with curiosity:

- How did God come alive? What was before God?
- But what about the Big Bang? How do dinosaur fossils fit into the Creation Story?
- If Adam and Eve had only two sons, how did the rest of the world get populated?
- Is the Bible true?
- What do I say when friends at school say, "What? You don't believe in the Bible?"
- Why do our girls have a choice about wearing a kippah but boys are required to wear them?
- Why is a growing vine used as schach for a sukkah not considered kosher?
- How does a Torah get made? How many scrolls are there in the world? Where is the first one?
- Why do some of the letters in a Torah scroll look stretched out?
- Why do they always want to kill us?



Each classroom teacher has been given a coping strategy that sounds like this, "That's a great question! Let's write that in the 'Parking Lot Questions for the Rabbi.'" We ensure that Rabbi Eligberg becomes aware of his parking lot questions and that he visits the classrooms with answers based on his level of learning, perspective, and experience with curious students. Social Action Update



2025 Reflections:

Throughout 2025, our community leaned into learning, service, and stewardship with a spirit that carried across every project and gathering. From powerful educational moments to hands-on environmental action, generous giving, and sustained support for neighbors in need, this year reflected our shared commitment to justice, care, and repair. The highlights below capture just some of the ways our congregation showed up for one another and for the wider world.

Eden Heilman's appearance as April's Shabbat Schmooze presenter, speaking about ACLU efforts on the national immigration front, was impactful and memorable.

The 2025 Operation Isaiah food drive was one of our most successful collections. We donated 863 pounds to the Virginia Peninsula Foodbank.

September brought a Reverse Tashlich beach clean-up, held in partnership with the Men's Club and Education Committee and inspired by Tikkun HaYam. Before we got to work, Leah Schwarz shared an overview of marine pollution and practical ways we can respond.

In October, our Shabbat Schmooze shifted the spotlight to Environmental Stewardship, with Leah guiding congregants on a nature walk around the synagogue's back ponds.

2025's December PORT (People Offering Resources Together) Winter Shelter volunteering, led by Allen Fraley and Ann Chapman, served a record number of people. Thanks to our congregants for volunteering and generous donations to support this annual project. We also donated hygiene kits put together by Ann from the toiletries collected.

Our prescription pill bottle collection has exceeded expectations, with Ann Chapman, EJ Tench, and Leah Schwarz powering the project by cleaning and processing the bottles, which will be reused rather than sent to our landfills.

We continued to donate toiletries to Transitions Family Violence Center and THRIVE Peninsula.

Shoshana Marziano and Steve Meyerson have been working on the energy audit and HVAC thermostat assessment as part of our Climate Action Plan.


Give Your Prescription Pill Bottles a Second Life


